2009 RIESLING

This is a variety particularly well suited to the Great Southern and especially the Porongurups, with its cooler ripening conditions and colder night temperatures. Typically, the Riesling wines made from this region are crisp and dry and can age well.

The growing season for the 2009 Riesling was a cooler spring than usual, and, combined with the poor set (no's of grapes per bunch) this contributed to the very low yields. The ripening season was warm with little hot weather; perfect conditions for the Riesling vines. The weather during vintage was kind with predominately fine and moderate conditions with the fruit harvested in early April. The free run juice was obtained from very low extraction rates and fermented at cool temperatures with a neutral yeast to maximize the delicacy inherent in this variety,

Aroma

Beautifully clean kaffir lime & lemon sorbet characters with a delicately perfumed background.

Palate

This is classic Porongurup Riesling: refined mineral and citrus fruit characters. Has beautiful lime fruit flavours that are intense though still palate weight and a fresh, lingering acidity. Our best Riesling to date!

Cellaring

Riesling like this is fantastic at any age. Enjoy as a fresh young wine or cellar for some bottle age complexity. This wine should continue to drink well for – 6 + years.



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
